This Sunday also lands near our observance of Thanksgiving which is perfect. It celebrates Christ the messiah and king who has sovereign rule over all creation. We praise God, whose will it is to restore all things through God's well-beloved Son, the King of kings and Lord of lords, with the assurance that He will mercifully grant that the people of the earth, divided and enslaved by sin though we are, may be freed and brought together under Jesus' most gracious rule. The observance of Christ the King Sunday reminds us that the once small baby, born in a manger to humble servants of God, will live to serve and sacrifice for us to give us the renewal and hope of the new beginning of the King to come to rule the Kingdom to come.




